Gallus proudly presents another milestone in terms of customer value: the 2005 model of Gallus EM 280. Featuring new disengaged printing heads and other enhancements, it offers significant reductions in set-up waste and time. Read more about this press which is available by now!

With more than 650 units installed worldwide and the record sales in 2004, the Gallus EM 280 is the most successful combination press in the label market. The “Plug and Play” concept of the Gallus EM 280 is the **benchmark for easy process change** – flexo, screen and hot foil units can be exchanged tool-free within minutes, **every process is possible on any position**.

Even the range of substrates running on this press is huge: from self-adhesives to shrink-sleeve, from light paper to wraps. No matter what kind of job is required, the owner of a Gallus EM 280 is prepared.

Starting shipping in March 2005, the Gallus EM 280 has been improved with the following points:

- Disengaged flexo printing head
- Electrical longitudinal register adjustment
- Easy exchange of anilox rollers
- Easy exchange of impression cylinders
- New central touch screen panel

The most important enhancement is the new **disengaged flexo printing head**. It includes an individual drive for web transport and print unit. While normally any kind of register change has an influence on web tension and therefore takes a while before it can be evaluated, the disengaged drive keeps web tension untouched during register adjustments. The register change is evident within seconds, **set-up waste is reduced by 10 to 15%**, print quality significantly stabilized during the run. Combined with an automatic register control the new disengaged printing head reduces set-up-waste and time to a level which normally is only achievable with much more expensive servo presses.

There are several other improvements on the new Gallus EM 280: **electrical longitudinal register adjustment** to ease and speed up register corrections, **easy exchange of anilox rollers** without touching print settings and **easy exchange of impression cylinders** without cutting the web.

Finally, the **new central touch screen panel** offers the user an easy introduction into the world of the Gallus EM 280: Each function is explained with symbols and in three different languages. Software updates allow to keep the machine up-to-date with changing market demands.
