Welcome to Gallus Innovation Days 2018!







Heidelberg Sheetfed Label Production

This press is newly equipped upstream with a fully integrated screen printing unit for high opacity white and downstream with the Digital Embellishment Unit (DEU). This DEU can produce gloss and matt spot coatings and tactile relief effects in a single pass, all using atmospheric UV inkjet coatings.




Gallus Labelmaster Advanced

This machine will be presented with automatic transverse and longitudinal register control, which further emphasizes the ease of use of this press. The process exchange from flexographic printing unit to screen printing unit is easy to handle too.
