In January 2018, All4Labels München GmbH placed an order for a remarketed Gallus ECS340 equipped with 10 flexo printing units and a cold foil unit to add to its line-up of its existing machines. The new installation will be used to add to its production in the food and beverage market. "This new machine is our second ECS.
