Much like a vehicle inspection, the Gallus Fit-Check is designed to ensure your Gallus machine remains in top condition, helping to extend the longevity of your equipment. It provides clear insight into which components may require repair or replacement, ensuring your press maintains peak performance and long-term productivity.

How does it work?

During the Fit-Check, certified Gallus technicians will visit your site to perform a comprehensive inspection of your press. Using a structured checklist, they will assess the machine's condition and identify any maintenance needs. As part of the process, all relevant safety standards will be reviewed to help prolong the lifespan of your press and if required, technicians will also provide targeted feedback to your operators. In addition, a short refresher training will be conducted to ensure your team is equipped to maintain peak performance and ensure reliable machine operation.

The Fit-Check offers a comprehensive assessment of your machine's current technical condition. Upon completion, you will receive a detailed list of components identified as potentially needing repair or replacement. Please note that the Fit-Check is designed as a diagnostic evaluation and does not include the execution of extensive repair work.

Good to know:

To carry out the Fit-Check, it is essential that all necessary tooling and cleaning materials are provided by the customer. In addition, the process change carriage must be in proper working condition and ready for use at all times throughout the inspection.

The Fit-Check typically takes up to two days, during which the Gallus service team will perform an extensive inspection of your machine. Please note that the exact duration may vary depending on the machine's configuration and current condition. As a best practice, we recommend scheduling a Fit-Check once a year.



For which machines is a Fit-Check possible?

 The Fit-Check is available for all machines currently in active service, including: RCS, TCS, ECS, EMS, LM, LF, G1, and EM 280 v3.
